*We're thrilled you're planning to cast a line with us! To help everyone have a safe and enjoyable experience, we have a few simple **fishery rules** in place.*

They're designed to protect our fish, our beautiful environment, and to ensure fair fishing for all. Please take a moment to read them over before you begin.

Thanks for your cooperation, and we hope you have a fantastic time fishing!

- Please be aware of the overhead live electric wires when casting
- No marking of fish
- All Anglers to have a current EA rod license for fishing – to be shown on request
- No swimming, wading or paddling permitted
- Strictly no keep nets unless authorised by the management
- No trout pellets or tiger nuts
- Barbless hooks only
- Please use your own landing nets and unhooking mats
- All unused bait is to be taken home and not put into lakes
- Rods are not to be left unattended at any time or for any reasons
- All fish should be returned to the water immediately
- All fish photography should be held kneeling down and over an unhooking mat
- Under 16's must be accompanied by an adult at all times
- No fishing tackle to be left lying around the lake
- Abide by the country code
- You are allowed one dog with you at the peg but it must be kept on a lead at all times and any mess cleared up. We reserve the right to ask the dog to be moved if we need to move livestock through the field.
- Seasonal closing – we reserve the right to close the lake during periods of extreme heat or when the fish are spawning
